Please note: A failing grade in quarter 2 does not necessarily mean you have completely failed the course. Your grades for quarter 1 and quarter 2 will be averaged to determine whether or not you will receive credit for the semester.

Additionally: The student handbook states "If a student is absent unexcused from a course for more than 14 percent of school days during the quarter, then the student will fail the course for the quarter." In the case of Q2, 14% is 6 days.

Please take the opportunity to reflect on if your behavior in the classroom is directly related to your grade in the classroom.
