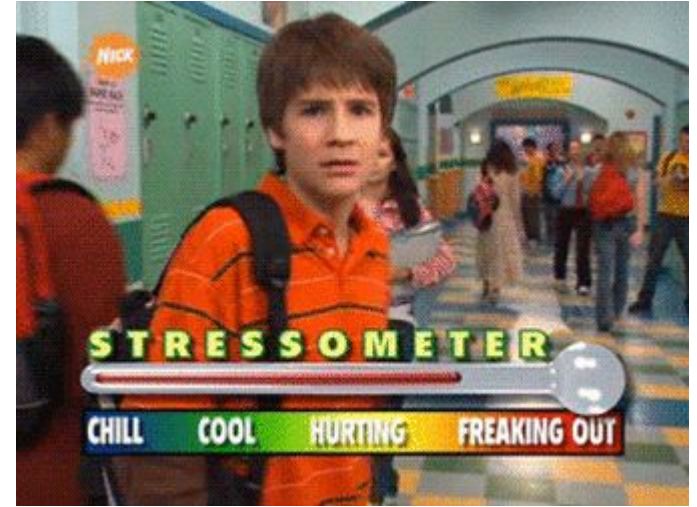

# WHY I LIKE KICKBOARD...

- ★ Part of PowerSchool (legally binding)
- ★ Quick, therefore realtime!
- ★ Can be on phone, tablet, or laptop
- ★ Tardiness tracker
- ★ Can be reversed easily if mistake is made



# OPTIMAL TIMES TO USE KICKBOARD & WHAT TO FOCUS ON...

## ★ DO NOW

- + Celebrate on-task behavior
- - Uniform checks, tardiness

## ★ DIRECT INSTRUCTION

- + Participation, above & beyond, insightful comments
- - Disruptions, off-task behavior

## ★ INDEPENDENT WORK

- + On-task behavior, brotherhood, collaboration
- - Disruptions, off-task behavior

## ★ EXIT TICKET/CLOSE OUT

- + On-task behavior, work completion, extra celebrations
- - Disruptions, off-task behavior



# USING KICKBOARD IN THE MOMENT...

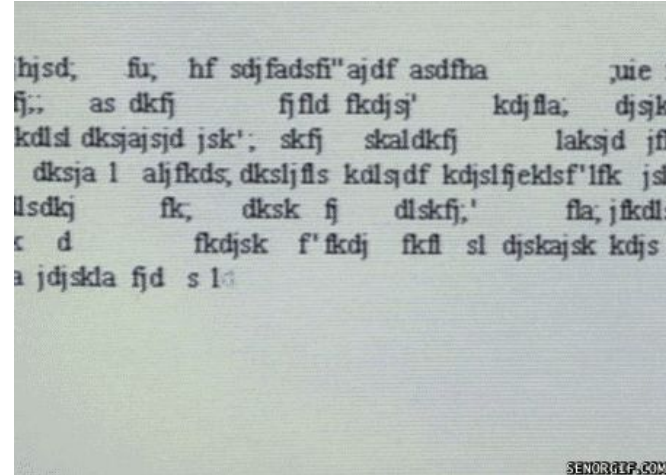


- ★ In the moment with technology
  - *I personally don't let TAs use Kickboard...*
- ★ Project Kickboard during various moments
- ★ Clipboard/chart (then input when you have time)
- ★ Old School Mrs. Jewls on the board

***Remember: Only click one corrective item per write up. (If a student does something that fits multiple items, pick the highest level infraction)***

# REFERRALS...

- ★ If and when you believe a student needs immediate disciplinary action, contact a dean so the student can be removed. Then, add a referral in kickboard!
  - Paper trail
  - Write a narrative, *recommend* a consequence
  - Deans have to respond to the referral in Kickboard, will likely contact you for more information
  - You will get an alert when it is “resolved”
- ★ If it is so bad that your safety is in jeopardy, make Ruth Gonzalez aware ([rgonzalez@boyslatin.org](mailto:rgonzalez@boyslatin.org)) so she can be sure to follow up with admin and ensure your safety.



# SOME CLARITY ABOUT THE HALLS...

- ★ **Cutting:** A student is out of your room for more than 10 minutes, even if they have a pass
- ★ **Elopement:** A student has left the room without permission/pass
- ★ **Tardy:** A student has come to class after the bell without a pass

A student can elope, but if they return within 10 minutes they are not cutting.

A student that is over 10 minutes late to your class without a pass is considered cutting AND tardy.





# WAYS I (MR. CELEIRO) LEVERAGE KICKBOARD...

- ★ Keep a tab open (different browser if possible)
- ★ Give students a chance to fix the behavior. If it persists, then it's time for kickboard!
  - I use this especially for profanity or harmful language
- ★ Narrate everything! (The good and the bad)
  - Use the Kickboard verbiage (i.e. “Thank you for that insightful comment,” “If you leave without a class, that’s eloping,” “Your collaboration is showing true brotherhood”)
- ★ Use it often to avoid timing out
- ★ Memorize your commonly used codes
  - If you use them enough, all you have to say is the code number and kids will stop! (2.15 Physical Aggression, etc.)





# MY COMMONLY USED CODES...

- ★ 1.1 Community Compliance (phones, cursing, unprepared)
- ★ 1.2 Disruptive Behavior
- ★ 1.5 Tardiness
- ★ 2.3 Cutting
- ★ 2.5 Disorderly Conduct
- ★ 2.6 Elopement
- ★ 2.15 Physical Aggression (this includes play-fighting)

# SOME TRICKS OF THE TRADE...

- ★ To follow along, go ahead and open Kickboard.

  - Purchase Mode (“How much Kickboard do I have?”)
  - Referrals
  - Analysis page
