



## VOCABULARY

- ★ Design Concept: The specifics of what you want the audience to see/hear/feel. It is the lens through which you design and present a production.
- ★ The 12 Elements of Technical Theatre

Sets	Lights	Hair	Masks
Set Dressings	Sound	Wigs	Special Effects
Props	Costumes	Makeup	Stage Management

Representational: Meant to look and be experienced as real



#### Presentational:

Purposefully not 100% realistic, may nod to a time period without being perfectly accurate, more about mood and theme.



#### Minimalist:

Purposefully
little/no design
that supports
the setting,
time period, and
mood.



#### Found Concept:

Use of small elements/props that may be integrated into the scenery, usually small cast when should be large



#### Actor/Musician:

Actors double as the orchestra and play their own instruments



## In the style of...:

Emulating the aesthetic of a specific genre or famous pre-established design concept



#### Skeletal:

Purposefully sparse design concepts with pockets of emptiness, especially in the set



#### High Concept:

Very unapologetic use of a concept that is contrary to the setting, time period, or mood of the text



Forward Concept: Use of a concept that supports the setting, time period, or mood of the text to the <u>extreme</u>



#### Immersive:


Design makes audience feel like they are in the play/play happens around the audience, detail crucial

## Sweeney Todd

Setting: London

Time Period: 1846

Mood: Bleak, dark, hollow, tragic, macabre

Themes: Vengeance, murder, madness, deceit

Using a cast of 10, this production is stylized as a framework piece of Tobias' memory of what has happened after he has been arrested for murder. The characters in the show emerge from the psychiatric ward Tobias is now living in as he recounts the tale of Sweeney Todd.

High Concept

Marketed as a concert performance, this production will surprise audiences. Dressed in black-tie attire, the actors will destroy their nice clothes and the set in the opening number to create a hostile, unsettling environment of Sweeney Todd in the modern world.



#### Representational

Set in 1846, London, this production will create realistic settings and present the action as initially intended by the author. To support the use of multiple locations, the design will incorporate brief representational moments for the sake of practicality.

Using his trademark aesthetic, Tim Burton will create a true historic London that is further dampened by the darkness of Sweeney Todd's history with colorless costumes and sunken appearances.

Immersive


Utilizing a fully functioning pie shop, audiences will enjoy meat pies while the action occurs around them in a true atmosphere. Presentational elements and found objects will be used to account for multiple locations within the text.

To highlight the emptiness Sweeney Todd feels, the scenery will be a mere skeleton of itself, with costumes that are purposefully incomplete in historic context.
